

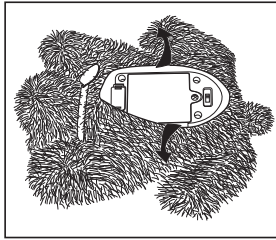


## Installing Batteries

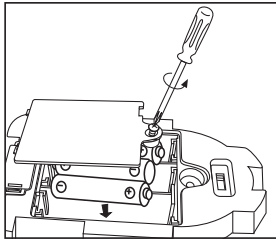
**ATTENTION:** Batteries should only be installed by an adult. The "Hug N' Heal" Pet Doctor comes with 3 "AAA" (R3) batteries already installed. These batteries are meant for in-store demonstration use only, and should be replaced with new ones.

To replace the batteries:

1. The battery compartment is located on the bottom/belly of the dog, protected by a flap. Pull back/separate the flap to expose the battery compartment. Use a Philips head screwdriver to open the door to the battery compartment.



2. Install three "AAA" (R3) batteries into the battery compartment, making sure that the + and - polarities match the diagram inside.
3. Close the battery compartment door, tighten the battery door screw and close the flap.

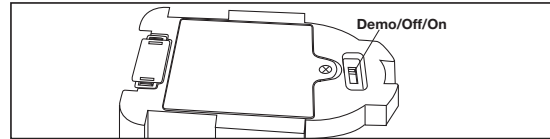


### For the Best Possible Performance

- We recommend the use of alkaline batteries for longer life.
- Different types of batteries or new and used batteries are not to be mixed.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- Batteries are to be inserted with correct polarity.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the unit.
- Do not attempt to recharge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Do not mix old and new batteries
- Do not alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the unit before charging.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be recharged under adult supervision (if removable)
- Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the toy before being charged. (if removable)
- The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.
- Batteries should be removed if the item is not going to be needed for an extended period of time (approximately 30 days or more) to prevent leakage or damage to the unit.

## Getting Started

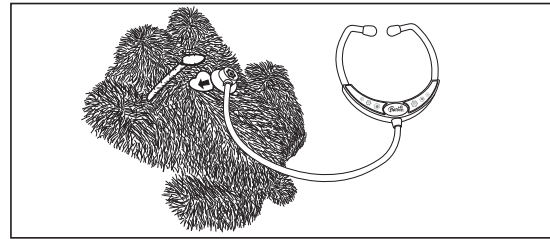
Thank you for purchasing the "Hug N' Heal" Pet Doctor. This play pet should provide hours of stimulating, trouble-free fun. Let's learn how your pet works.



Pull back the flap on the dog's belly to expose the battery compartment and mode switch. By default, the mode switch is set to "DEMO" for in-store demonstration. Set the switch to ON for normal play. If the dog won't be played with for a while, remember to turn the switch to OFF to save battery life.

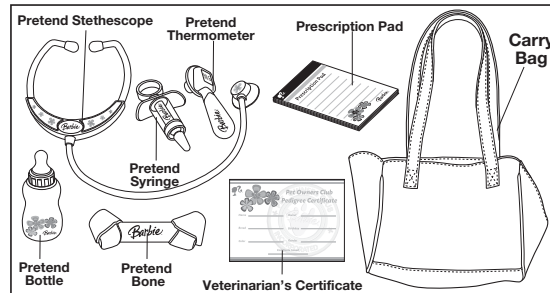
**NOTE:** The dog will "sleep" (power down automatically) if left idle for a few minutes. Wake her up again by "petting" any button.

## Be a Vet

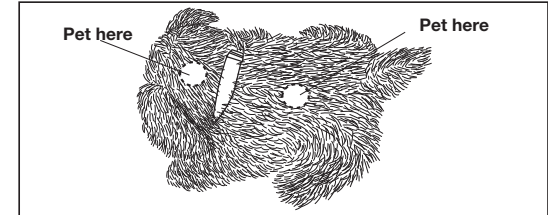


Your dog comes with items a real vet needs to care for a pet. To check your dog's heartbeat, place the earpieces of the stethoscope in your ears and hold the other end over the dog's heart. You will hear it beating, strong and true. You also have a pretend thermometer, syringe, a prescription pad and a Veterinarian's certificate you can fill out.

## Pet the Dog



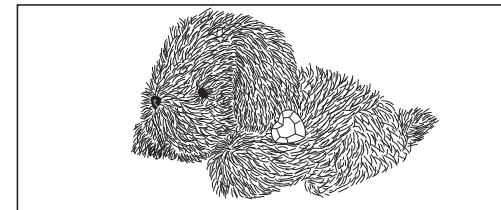
Press the dog's paws or firmly pet the dog's head and back to hear panting, growls, barks and whines.

## Feed the Dog



Your dog loves to eat. Hold the bottle or bone up to his mouth and listen! **NOTE:** You may have to move the bottle or bone about to find the ideal triggering position.

## Heart Feeling



Your dog has a glowing heart that fills up with light to show when she's happy. When the light in the heart gets low, the dog will whine: your pet wants attention! To restore your pet's happiness level, feed it a bone, and pat it in trigger areas until the heart is fully lit.
