

Maintenance

It is important to keep the Barbie Keyboard as dry and clean as possible. Clean the unit with a soft cloth moistened only with mild soap and water. Stronger cleaning agents, such as thinner or similar materials are not recommended, as they may damage the surface of the case.

Keep the Barbie Keyboard away from direct sunlight or sources of excessive heat.

Do not allow dirt, sand, small particles, water or other liquids to enter the toy's casing.

If the toy is to be left unused for an extended time period, such as a month or longer, have an adult remove the battery to extend its life and to prevent leaking or corrosion.

Protect your furniture when placing the unit on a natural oil or lacquered finish. A cloth or other protective material should be placed between the unit and the furniture.

Troubleshooting

If improper operation occurs, press the reset button located on the front of the unit.

If the toy still does not play, check the batteries. They are probably weak and need to be replaced with new batteries.

If the unit still does not work after changing the batteries, make sure you have installed them properly, with the + and - polarities matching the diagram printed inside the battery compartment.

If there is a distorted or fuzzy sound, the batteries may be weak. Replace with new batteries.

If problems persist, **do not attempt to repair the toy yourself**. See the warranty for factory service information.

2. Enclose a photocopy of your sales receipt, credit card statement, or other proof of the date of purchase.
3. Enclose a check or money order payable to the order of KIDdesigns, for the sum of \$9.00.
4. Send the unit prepaid to the Factory Service Center listed below.

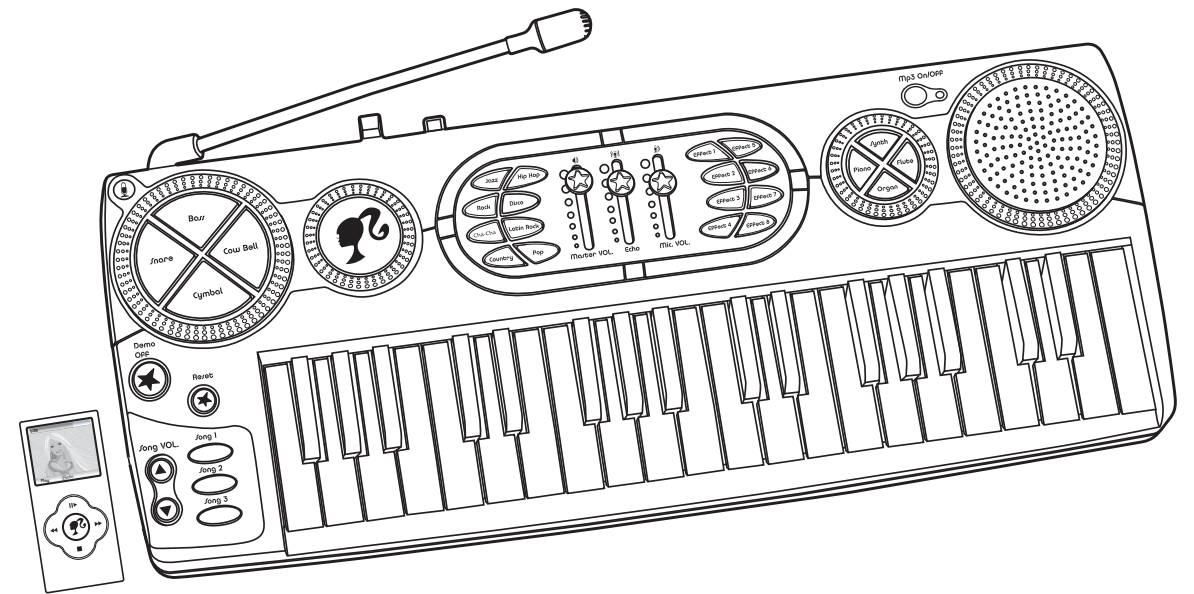

Important Message to Consumers

Thank you for purchasing one of Barbie™'s top-quality electronic products. We would appreciate it if you take a few moments to read through these instructions. This will help you understand the safe and proper way to use this product, and to help give it the long-lasting life that Barbie™ products are designed for.

Keep these instructions for future reference as they contain important information.

Installing the Batteries

ATTENTION: Batteries should only be installed by an adult.

The unit should come with 4 "AA" (R6) batteries already installed. These batteries are meant for in-store demonstration use only, and should be replaced with fresh batteries. To replace the batteries, follow these instructions:

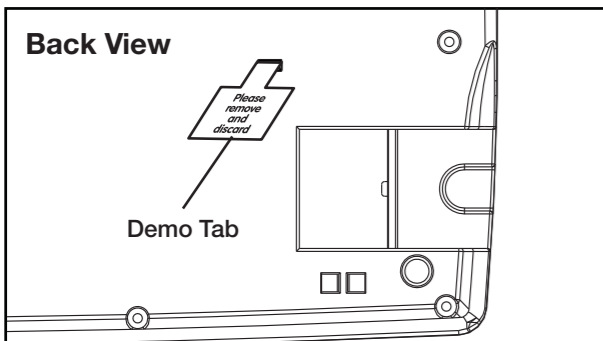
1. The battery compartment is located on the back side of the toy. Use a Phillips screwdriver to open the battery compartment door.
2. Install 4 "AA" (R6) size batteries into the compartment, making sure that the + and - polarities match the diagram printed inside.
3. Close the battery compartment door and tighten the battery door screw.

For the Best Possible Performance

- We recommend the use of alkaline batteries for longer life.
- Different types of batteries or new and used batteries are not to be mixed.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- Batteries are to be inserted with correct polarity.
- Remove exhausted batteries from the unit.
- Do not attempt to recharge non-rechargeable batteries.
- Remove rechargeable batteries from the unit before charging.
- The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.
- Batteries should be removed if the item is not going to be needed for an extended period of time (approximately 30 days or more) to prevent leakage or damage to the unit.
- Rechargeable batteries should only be charged under adult supervision.

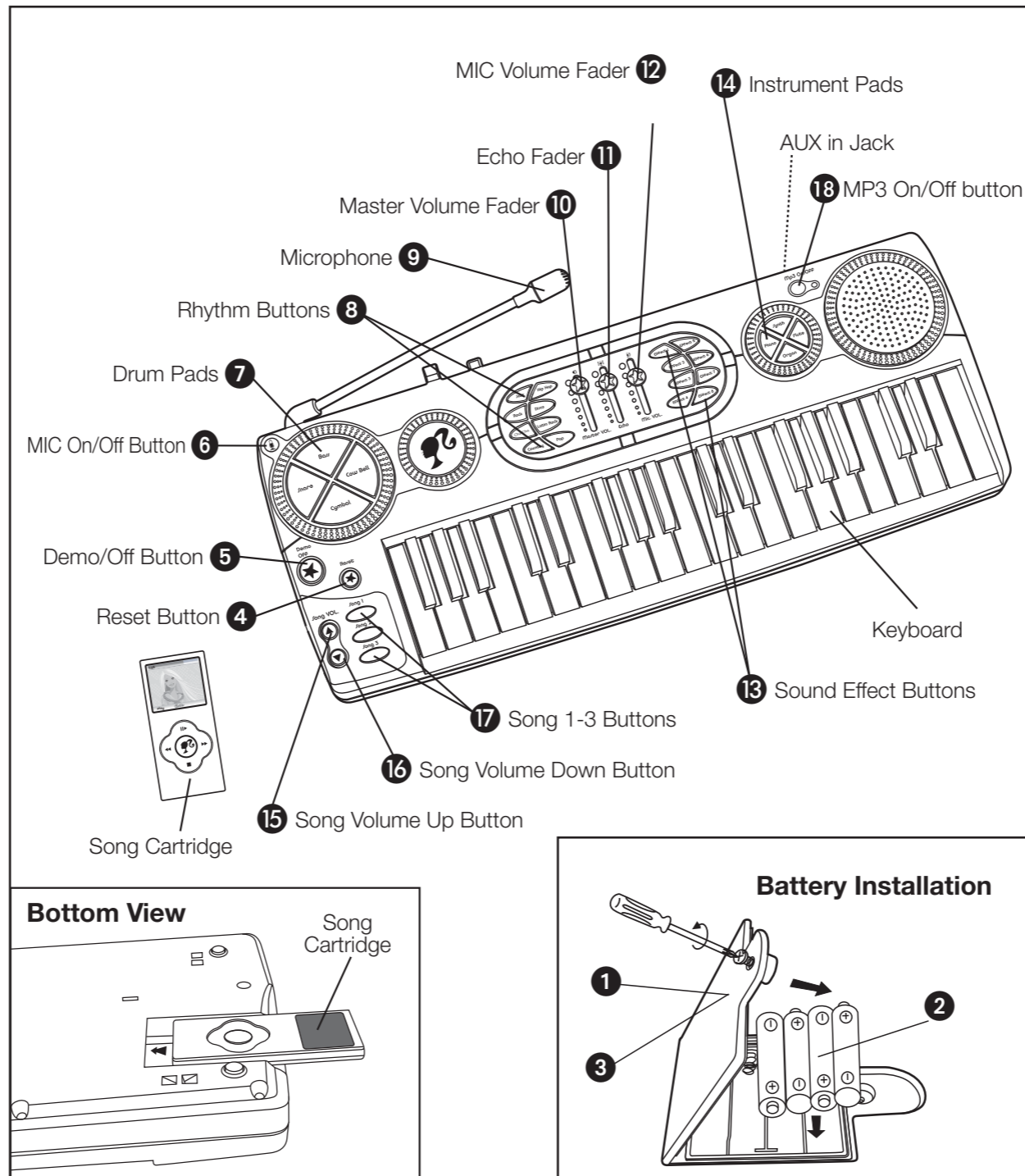
Remove Demo Tab

The Barbie™ Keyboard has a demo tab for in-store demonstration purposes. Make sure to remove this tab. To do so, gently pull on tab. Dispose of tab properly.



Adjusting the Volume

Use the **10 Master Volume Fader**, located on the middle of the unit, to adjust the overall volume.



Playing with the Barbie Keyboard

The Barbie Keyboard is a fun toy that plays like a real electronic keyboard. You can create your own music, sing together with music and cool sound effects, play along with eight different rhythm tracks or sing and play along with the pop songs on the song cartridge. Read these instructions to learn how to have lots of fun with your new keyboard.

Turning the Keyboard On/Off – To turn on the Keyboard, just press any key. The unit will automatically turn off if there is no input for about 20 seconds. You can also turn it off immediately by pressing the **5 Demo/Off Button** or **4 Reset Button**; you will hear a beep tone indicating the unit is off.

Demo – When the unit is off, press the **5 Demo/Off Button** once to hear Barbie describe what the keyboard can do.

Create Music – Press keys on the keyboard to create your own music. To switch the keyboard instrument sound to Piano, Synth, Flute or Organ, press the related **14 Instrument Pad**. Press any one of the **8 Rhythm Buttons** to play that rhythm track as background music to sing and play to. There are four **7 Drum Pads** on the left hand side; press any pad to make that drum sound. Also, you can press one of the **13 Sound Effect Button** to activate cool sound effects. Use the Master Volume fader to control the overall volume. **Song Cartridge** – Insert the song cartridge (label side out) into the slot on the bottom left of the keyboard, then press **17 Song 1 - 3 key** to play a song. You can use the **15 Song Volume Up** or **16 Down Button** to adjust song loudness. When playing along to the song cartridge, the keyboard automatically plays in tune with the songs.

Microphone Function – At any time, press and hold the **6 MIC On/Off button** then begin singing into the MIC. Your voice will come out of the speaker mixed with any other sound source that is playing. Use the **12 MIC volume Fader** to adjust the microphone volume. Adjust the **11 Echo Fader** for awesome echo effect. To turn the microphone OFF, release the **6 MIC On/Off Button**. **TIP:** To avoid annoying feedback (piercing squealing sound), keep microphone volume low and mic pointed away from the speaker.

Using the AUX In Jack with your iPod® or any MP3 player

You can connect your Barbie™ Jam with Me Electronic Keyboard to an iPod® or any MP3 player to play your own music through the keyboard.

Connect your iPod® or MP3 player to Barbie™ Jam with Me Electronic Keyboard by using an audio cable (not included) from the device's headphone or audio out jack to the AUX in jack located to the right on the back panel.

Press play on your iPod® or MP3 player. Press **18 MP3 On/Off button** to play your MP3 for 10 minutes (the Keyboard will auto shut off after 10 minutes). Press again to keep playing MP3.

Adjust the overall volume using the Master Volume fader on the Keyboard
